

Demonstrate how you meet the seven key competences of Chartered membership

When you apply to become a Chartered Resources & Waste Manager, you are required to show that you meet the seven key competences needed to achieve Chartered status. This template is designed to help you think about and demonstrate how you meet those competences.

You can find details of each of the competences on p.12-14 of our **Application Guidance Notes**. Under each competence, there are several sub-headings which will help you add more detail to your answers and give you plenty of opportunities to showcase the breadth of your knowledge and understanding of the sector.

When writing about how you demonstrate each competence, you might choose to use these sub-headings to help structure your answers, or you can write more broadly if you prefer. The most important thing is to ensure that you cover all aspects of each competence in your answers.

When giving examples of how you meet these competences, we encourage you to focus on your input and involvement, not that of your team. We are looking for evidence that you have views and opinions of your own, and you should therefore concentrate on using "I" rather than "we" in your answers.

There is no word limit for your answers, however we recommend that the document does not exceed four pages in length once completed.
